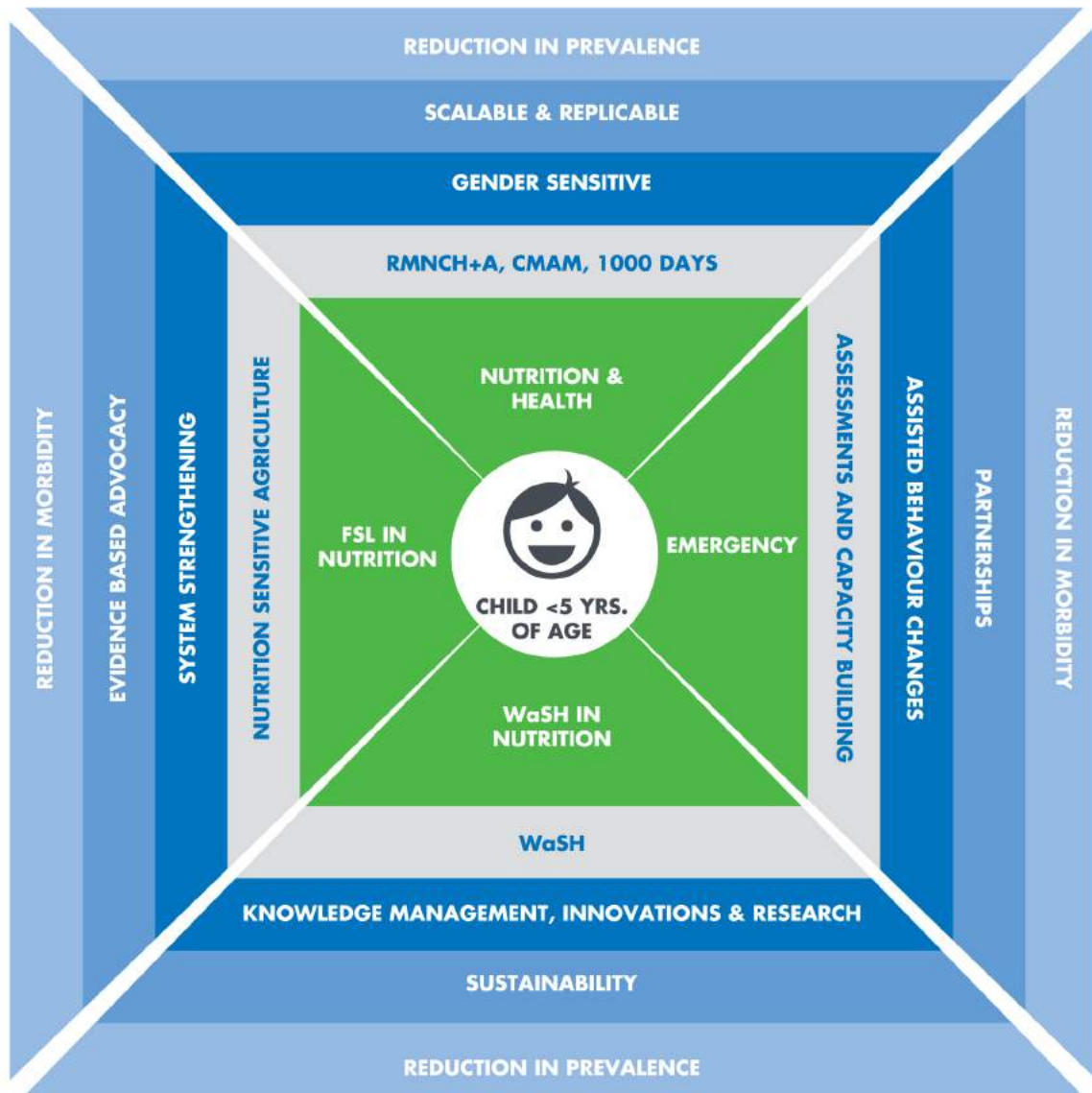


We work with **local Governments** and partners to integrate our work into their policies and institutions, **extending the scope** of our projects and providing them with **sustainability**.

WE WORK AGAINST MALNUTRITION IN INDIA

Almost twenty million children in India under five years of age suffer from acute malnutrition, one of the worst forms of hunger. Nine million Indian children under five currently suffer from severe acute malnutrition, their bodies becoming extremely thin and skeletal. Almost one million children die due to a malnutrition related cause.

And worse still, children with acute malnutrition are almost eleven times more likely to die before the age of five than healthy children. This medical emergency situation calls for urgent action by the Government, Foundations, Civil Society, Individuals and the Public at large.

Ending child deaths from malnutrition is well within our grasp. We take decisive action against the causes and effects of malnutrition and currently work in the states of Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan. These states present a high prevalence of undernutrition among the tribal population and have been identified by the NFHS as a part of the critical zones in terms of under 5 children being underweight, and the prevalence of stunting and wasting.

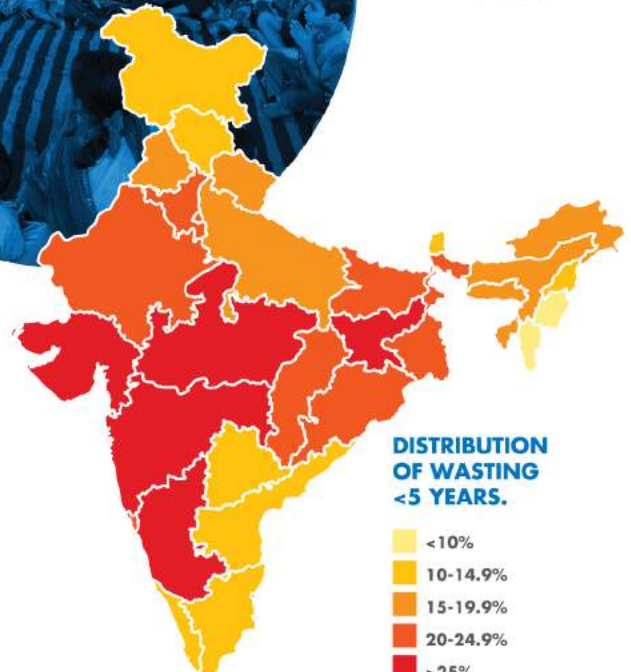

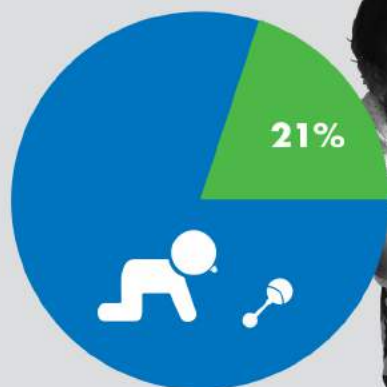

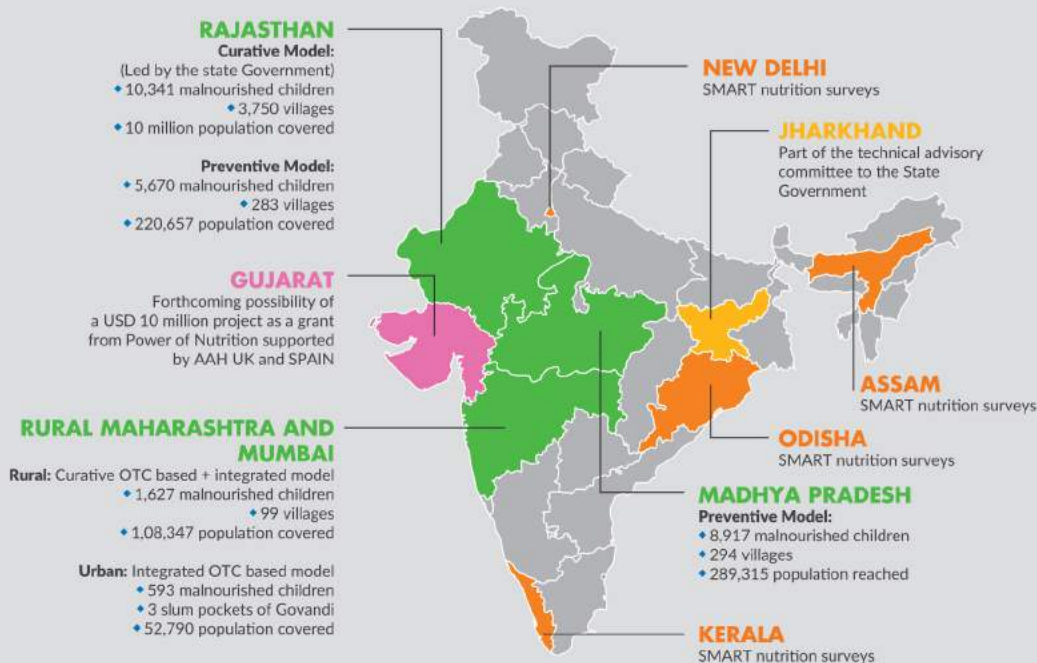
