A world free from hunger is a world where our children have nutritious food, where they have access to clean drinking water and can live in a hygienic environment.

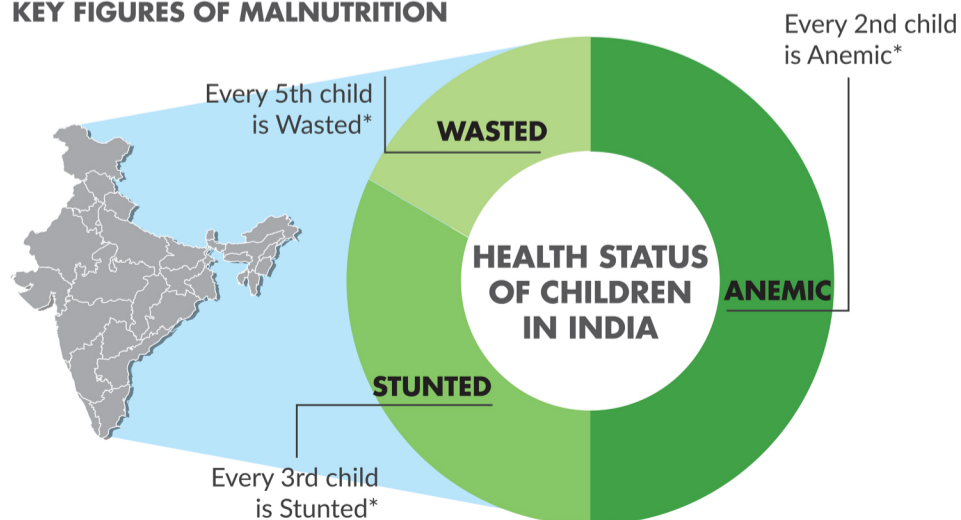

## WE WORK AGAINST MALNUTRITION

9 million children in India suffer from severe acute malnutrition, the worst form of hunger. 1 million children die due to malnutrition related causes. Malnutrition is preventing millions of our children from reaching their potential, impairing their physical and mental development. But the good news is that we can stop children from dying of hunger. Fight Hunger Foundation has been working tirelessly since its inception in 2012 to address this emergency situation and help children regain their basic human right- that of a life of dignity and the right to food.

## WE WORK FOR CHILDREN

We have impacted the lives of 700,000 people across the 680 villages in the states of Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan. We work with children, adolescent girls and boys, pregnant and lactating mothers and Government frontline workers. Our approach is to tackle both the causes and effects of malnutrition, thereby our programs are both curative and preventive.



**2,37,583** people received actionable information on nutrition and hygiene through 22,030 community education sessions



**90,000** children under 5 years of age were screened to identify signs of acute malnutrition



**16,000** children suffering from acute malnutrition received treatment and some with medical conditions were referred to treatment centres



**13,000** Government frontline workers were trained by us and they can now identify early signs of Malnutrition and can take corrective action



**10,000** pregnant and lactating mothers now better understand Anti-Natal and Post Natal Care



**747** doctors now actively use effective global standards in malnutrition treatment protocol

## WE WORK TOGETHER

This multi layered, synchronized endeavour was made possible by the generous support of our partners and stakeholders and the 140 strong team of change makers at Fight Hunger Foundation.



**40 GOVERNMENT STRUCTURES** such as Anganwadi Centres (AWC's) and Mother and Child Treatment Centres (MTC's) now see an improvement in attendance of children



**4 MOU'S** have been signed between the State Governments of Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Jharkhand and Fight Hunger Foundation to tackle malnutrition



**4 STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS** with ICDS, UNICEF, Indian Railways and Krishi Vigyan Kendra (Indian Council of Agricultural Research) for research and innovation in programs



**2 HOSPITALS** have been equipped and their staff have been trained for treating children with malnutrition
