Inauguration of 26 Refurbished Anganwadi Centres with support from SBI MF



We inaugurated over 26 refurbished Anganwadi Centres across Dhar (MP) and Gariaband (Chhattisgarh) with support from SBI Mutual Fund. These improved spaces now benefit a total of 1,078 children, with attendance rising from 51% to over 80%, reflecting renewed community trust.


